Dominic Foos turns Professional

Crans-sur-Sierre, Switzerland, September 3rd, 2014 – Today, on his 17th birthday, Dominic Foos (born September 3, 1997) turns pro. The German top amateur will debut as a playing professional tomorrow at European Tour's Omega European Masters, held at the Crans-sur-Sierre GC, Crans Montana, Switzerland. Foos will tee off his first round at 14:20 h together with Robert-Jan Derksen und Pariya Junhasavasdikul.

„I feel ready for this change and looking forward with excitement to take the next step in my golf career“, says the young German talent. Dominic Foos has been practising and playing at professional level in the past years. That allowed him to develop himself to one of the most successful German amateur players ever.

At the age of 12 Dominic was already „scratch“, recording a „plus handicap“ as a 13-year-old. At the age of 15 Dominic was the best amateur of his age in the world and best German amateur throughout all ranks. Among numerous national and international victories Dominic won the German International Boys Amateur Championship twice. As youngest winner ever he secured the title of the 2013 French International Boys Champion. He also gained experience on the PGA European Tour. At the Commericalbank Qatar Masters in January this year Dominic Foos finished 16th as best German player in the field showing a strong performance.

„I enjoyed a great amateur career with lots of unforgettable successes, that I am happy to look back upon. But now I am looking into the future“, says the 17-year-old.

In the following week Dominic Foos will compete in the KLM Dutch Open (European Tour) at the Kennemer Golf & County Club, Zandvoort, Holland.
